

How to Vote By Mail in Massachusetts During COVID-19

REQUEST YOUR BALLOT EARLY, SEND IT BACK EARLY
& FILL IT OUT CAREFULLY



1.) REGISTER TO VOTE OR VERIFY YOU'RE REGISTERED

This is easy to do online at:

2.) FILL OUT YOUR "NO EXCUSE NEEDED" MAIL-IN BALLOT APPLICATION.

Once you are registered to vote, you should receive your ballot application in the mail. **Check the box to vote by mail in 'All 2020 elections'** to receive a ballot for the primary & general.



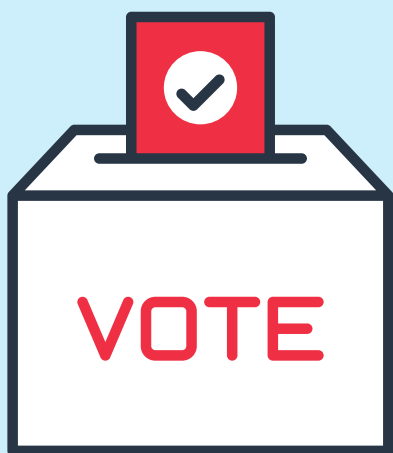
3.) RETURN YOUR APPLICATION ON TIME

Return by 8/26 for the primary & 10/28 for the general, but best to submit it as early as possible!

Applications can be emailed, mailed, faxed or hand delivered (see below). You'll receive your ballot by mail after submitting your application.

4.) FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS ON THE BALLOT

Fill out your ballot carefully! Read all the instructions. Fill out ballots with a black pen or felt tip marker, stay within the circle & sign your ballot properly.



5.) RETURN YOUR BALLOT ON TIME

PRIMARY: Ballot received by 8pm on 9/1.

GENERAL: Ballot postmarked no later than November 3 & back at your local election office no later than November 6.

Don't wait until the last minute; send it back early!

APPLICATIONS CAN BE EMAILED, MAILED, OR DROPPED OFF TO THE TOWN CLECK. **BALLOTS** CAN BE MAILED OR DROPPED OFF.
